-3 Doubles teams for the EBAL Tournament

-Note: remaining positions in the Singles and Doubles draw of 32 will be selected in order of finish by teams during the EBAL season (i.e. 1st place team can choose an extra Singles player or Doubles team, 2nd place team can choose an extra Singles or Doubles team, 3rd and 4th place teams fill make selections to fill out the open positions in the Singles and Doubles draw)

-Preliminary Round: 10-game pro set with tiebreakers at 10-10

-2nd Round and Quarterfinals: No Add Scoring

10:00 a.m. Tournament Begins

*Each school brings 1 Doubles team (note – team can consist of 1 or more participants from the NCS Singles Qualifying Tournament)

***Preliminary Round: 10-Game Pro-Set; Quarterfinals/Semi-Finals: No Add Scoring**

Monday, November 11th (NCS Doubles Qualifying Final Rounds) – San Ramon Valley HS

12:30 p.m. – Coaches Meeting/Players Warm-up

1:00 p.m. – Tournament Continues/Concludes

*Winner of the NCS Doubles Qualifying Tournament will play the winner of the EBAL Doubles Tournament to determine which team will represent the EBAL at NCS

*Final match will take place no fewer than 30 minutes and no longer than 60 minutes following the conclusion of the NCS Doubles Qualifying Tournament

***All Matches will be played with Add Scoring**

General Notes:

- The cost to the EBAL for renting Crow Canyon Country Club on November 7-8 is \$500
- There will be an additional cost of \$250 to pay for a USTA official for Thursday and Friday
- Each team is responsible for bringing 10 cans of tennis balls**
- All coaches and players should be prepared to serve as line judges
